In my personal matter I was granted a suiters grant and the defendant (a large registered club) is pursuing me for \$150,000.00 which is the balance of their court costs. I do not have any assets and I am on disability pension and I know that I am not alone in my circumstances.

I can stand losing but find the courts decision to expect me to pay any court costs beyond anyones comprehension and I feel these decisions are an erosion of peoples right to justice and a 'fair deal'.

I believe that the review before you falls short of the real issues facing people in the court system and needs to be addressed to protect the everyday citizens from overzealous large corporations and their threats to peoples lively hood and homes.

These large organisations accept the suiters grant which is awarded because of the persons financial situation and should be all they get not be able to persue any other monies maybe changes to the guidelines of this fund need change to remedy this 'grab for government money' and still be able to persue victims such as myself.
